

Common Agricultural Policy

This is the combination of ecology with agriculture. It is a way of life and the language of Nature.

Permaculture

Is a movement that allows food to go straight from the farm, directly to people's tables. This means supporting local farmers and getting fresh produce.

Agro-ecology

This is an organic material that can be added to soil to help plants grow. It is made through the decomposition of organic matter and can be produced at home. This makes fruit and veg peel fo back into the soil, completing a natural cycle.

Farm to Fork

These are foods that grow in a specific time of the year. Fruit and vegetables grow in specific seasons. For example, tomatoes and watermelon grow in warm summer months, while cabbages and beetroots grow in colder winter months in Malta.

Food Sovereignty

Food that is produced in the area. In Malta, local food is food produced in the country. By eating this food we are supporting local farmers and reducing CO2 emissions caused by food transportation.

Farmers

Is a way of growing food that works with nature rather than against it, to create an ecosystem that works. It focuses on creating systems that can sustain themselves permanently after a while.

Local Food

These are people that work hard every day to grow food for all of us to eat.

Seasonal Food

This includes all processes and infrastructure involved in feeding a population: growing, harvesting, processing, packaging, transporting, marketing, consumption, and disposal of food and food-related items.

Compost

The CAP is one of the oldest policies of the European Union dedicated to agriculture and rural development. It has been ongoing since 1962. At that time, it aimed at developing agricultural production to feed the European people after the end of World War 2.

Food System

This is the right of peoples to healthy and culturally appropriate food produced through ecologically sound and sustainable methods, and their right to define their own food and agriculture systems.
